Students at the retreat are each assigned to a small chamber ensemble where they receive coaching throughout the week from the faculty and the retreat counselors. In addition to the small ensembles, all students participate in a chamber orchestra. Students also have the opportunity to attend master classes and participate in fiddling, viola, and cello choirs. Performances include the student quartet concert and the Mountains & Strings Chamber Orchestra concert in Harriman State Park. Outdoor activities during the week include daytime and evening hikes in Harriman State Park, outdoor barbecues, games, and initiative classes.
